Year 3 Trip to Sea City Museum

Dear Parents and Carers

To support the next half terms topic of The Titanic, we have planned a fantastic trip to the Sea City Museum in Southampton which will take place on Friday 30th April 2021.

We appreciate that current guidelines are that trips and visits are not taking place.

However, we are being optimistic in planning this trip and would like to give every parent the opportunity to spread the cost. Should we need to cancel for any reason you will receive a full refund.

We will be travelling by coach to the museum and children will need to be in full school uniform. They will need to wear sensible shoes or black trainers, along with a waterproof coat. We will leave school at 9.30am and return to school for 2:45pm approximately.

Children will need a packed lunch to be eaten at the museum. This can be brought from home or ordered through the school. Children who are entitled to a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch from school. Please ensure your child has a drink in their lunchbox, although fizzy drinks are not permitted.

The children will take part in a workshop learning about life on board the Titanic and visiting the museums special exhibition about the Titanic Story. There will also be time to view the exhibit; Titanic: The Legend.

To assist us with the cost we are asking every parent for a contribution of £12 per child. This includes the entry fee to the museum and the coach trip to and from Southampton.

To make your contribution manageable, we are suggesting four monthly instalments over 12 weeks (equivalent of £1 per week) outlined in the payment schedule below.

£3 by 29th January

£3 by 26th February

£3 by 26th March

£3 due on 23rd April 2021

or a single payment of £12 to be received by 29 January 2021.
