

This year marks the 25th Anniversary of the notorious and much-loved 'World Book Day', which is being held on Thursday 3rd March 2022. To promote and celebrate World Book Day, all children are invited to come into school dressed up as their favourite story book character, bringing in a copy of the books to share with their peers, if they've got one. If children do not want to dress up as their favourite story book character, they are welcome to come in wearing their school uniform instead.

Children will be bringing home with them a 'World Book Day' token which can be taken to any participating store and exchanged for one of the selected free books. Alternatively, they can put their token towards the purchase of any book. Please make sure that you check your local shops to ensure that they accept these tokens before buying any books. Shops that are part of the World Book Day scheme include Asda and WHSmith.

We are asking all children, during half term, to create their favourite book character out of whatever they choose. Whether it's a cross-stitched Elmer, a potato Harry Potter, an egg box Hungry Caterpillar, or a knitted Mr Twit, we would love to see how creative you and your children can get! Certificates will be given to all children who enter the competition and prizes will be awarded to the most creative book character creation within each class. The competition will be held on Thursday 3rd March so please make sure that your child has brought their crafty creation into school by then.
