Dear Parents

This term the children's main topic is Castles and Knights. The children will be learning about the Legend of King Arthur and the Knights of the Round Table. We will be visiting Winchester Great Hall and The Westgate Museum for them to learn how to be a Knight - Knight School!

We will be looking at the replica Round Table and learning about a knight's job, led by Mrs Overthrow or Miss Sheehan and our amazing student Jake Humphries. Jack will be acting the role of a Knight and engaging the children in Knight School. The children will also get to handle real armour to see how heavy it was, at the Westgate Museum. They will also get to see the view over Winchester on the ramparts and how the Westgate defended the city.



This visit will take place on 12th November 2021, during the school day. Children will need to wear school uniform and it is essential they bring a warm coat. Please can your child either bring in a packed lunch or order a school packed lunch for the day.
