

We are expected to wear our school uniform at all times. This includes sensible, black school shoes. We understand that if we do not wear the correct footwear or uniform, we may have to wear plimsolls or some spare uniform for the day.



Swearing, bullying, fighting, hurting others, stealing and damaging property are all unacceptable. If we choose to behave this way, a number of things might happen:

- A letter may get sent home
- Our parents might have to come into school to discuss our behaviour
- We may get sent home. This is called "Excluded" and is very serious

Even if this behaviour happens outside of school, for example when we are walking home, it is still unacceptable and we may still be excluded.



Our Behaviour Policy

As children, we know that we learn best when we feel safe, cared for and believed in by everyone at our school. We know that we also have to play our part by allowing the adults to teach and by following our School Golden Rules

All of the adults in school will help us to behave properly by rewarding us when we do. Some of the rewards we can earn include:

- Praise
- Dojo points
- Showing our work
- Star Worker Certificate
- Stickers on our work
- Merit cards for getting to Green, leading to a Golden Badge for completing our Behaviour Passport

Our school uses a coloured 5 point behaviour management scale so we can see the consequences of our behaviour, both good and bad. We can move up the scale or down the scale, depending on the choices we make.


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|  | 1. Everyday, we start the day on yellow. This is a good place to be and shows that our behaviour is ok. |
|  | 2. We can move up to blue for following the school values and making good choices |
|  | 3. If we show outstanding behaviour and put in lots of effort with our work, we can move to green. This means we get a merit card! |
|  | 4. If we make wrong choices and do not put in effort we may move down to orange. This means we might miss 2 minutes of our play time. |
|  | 5. If we continue to make the wrong choice we may move down to red, We will then have to work in a different classroom. |

If we go to a different class and continue to make the wrong choice OR if our behaviour is unsafe, we may have to go to see Mrs Sharp, Mrs Trumble or Mrs Gosling. If they are busy, OR if our behaviour is really serious, we may have to see Mrs Beckett.

Our parents will be told if this happens.



We must only leave the classroom if we have asked an adult AND they have said yes. If we choose to leave the classroom without permission, we are not being safe.



We are not allowed to bring in toys or games from home unless our teacher has asked us to. If we do they will be taken away and kept in the office until the end of the day. Sometimes our parents may have to collect them.
